

SOME DO'S AND DONT'S

Do's


 For best results with the remote control, make sure the transmitter on the remote is in line with the receiver on GRiP's head.


Don't's

- Do not immerse GRiP or any parts in water, or any other form of liquid.
- Do not drop, throw, or kick GRiP as this might damage mechanical functions.
- Do not allow GRiP to roam near edges from which it could fall.

BATTERY INFORMATION

To change the batteries in GRiP, carefully lay it on its back. Do not place the robot where it could easily fall. To change the batteries in the remote controller.

Remote Controller Battery Diagram/Installation

Installing or changing batteries in GRiP / Remote Controller:

- 1. Using a Phillips screwdriver (not included) remove the screw on the battery compartment.
- 2. Insert the batteries according to the diagram. Ensure that the positive and negative polarities match the illustrations inside the battery compartment.
- 3. Replace the battery compartment cover and replace the screw using the screwdriver. Do not over-tighten.

LOW BATTERY INDICATORS:

GRIP

- When the batteries grow weak, GRiP will become less responsive and move or turn slowly. When this occurs, power OFF and replace all batteries
- NOTE: You will know when GRiP batteries are nearly depleted because it will make a sound.


Remote Controller - NOTE: You will know when the Remote Controller batteries are nearly depleted because GRiP will not respond to commands, or the distance from which the Remote Controller works will be shorter.

IMPORTANT BATTERY INFORMATION

- Use only fresh batteries of the required size and recommended type.
- Do not mix old and new batteries, different types of batteries [standard (Carbon-Zinc), Alkaline or rechargeable] or rechargeable batteries of different capacities.
- Remove rechargeable batteries from the toy before recharging them.
- Rechargeable batteries are only to be charged under adult supervision.
- Please respect the correct polarity, (+) and (-).
- Do not try to recharge non-rechargeable batteries.
- Do not dispose of batteries into fire.
- Replace all batteries of the same type/brand at the same time.
- The supply terminals are not to be short-circuited.
- Remove exhausted batteries from the toy.
- Batteries should be replaced by adults.
- Remove batteries if the toy is not going to be played with for some time.
- Batteries should be recycled or disposed of as per state and local guidelines.

GETTING STARTED

After you've inserted batteries into your GRiP and Remote Controller, your hardworking bud is ready to play!



Before turning GRIP on, place it on a large, even surface. Next, shift the Power Switch located on the back to ON.

PLAYING WITH GRIP

Once you've turned GRiP on, its time to get to work! GRiP will spin around in excitement.

There are two ways to play and interact with GRiP: build-up, and remote control.

POWER DOWN MODE


After 10 minutes of inactivity, GRiP will power down. To exit Power Down Mode, switch the power OFF then ON again.


SLEEP MODE


To conserve energy, the remote controller will enter sleep mode after 10 minutes of inactivity. To exit Sleep Mode, press any button on the remote controller.

BUILD UP

- GRiP comes with a set of gripper arms that are detachable. Mix and match attachments with other members from the BotSquad™!
- 2. GRiP's truck bed is compatible with the included bricks and other major builder brands. Build into GRiP's truck bed so GRiP can haul the load to the next job site!
- 3. Stickers: To give the included builder bricks some extra character, decorate GRiP and the Remote Controller with the included decals.







REMOTE CONTROL

The Remote Controller gives you full control over GRiP's motion and gripper arms. Drive GRiP around or activate fun game modes like guard, dance, sing, and free roam.

GRiPTM has two sets of wheels and can turn on the spot. To control it, point the Remote Controller at the IR Sensor located on GRiP's head.

	To make GRiP move forward, push the throttle upwards on the Remote Controller.	()/() HOLD	To spin on the spot, push the throttle to either fully left or fully right on the Remote Controller, and hold it there.
•	To make GRiP move backward, push the throttle downwards on the Remote Controller.		To make GRiP's gripper arms close, push the button on the bottom left of the Remote Controller.
(To make GRiP turn left, push the throttle to the left on the Remote Controller.		To make GRiP's gripper arms open, push the button on the bottom right of the Remote Controller.
>	To make GRiP turn right, push the throttle to the right on the Remote Controller.	+ 1	To toggle volume settings on GRiP, press the left and right buttons on the bottom of the Remote Controller at the same time.
